The objective of this tour is to provide civilians an inside look at the men and women who serve in today's armed services. The submarine service is a high security operation.

- Our tour includes Navy bus transport from and/to Keyport, an executive briefing at the headquarters, a tour of the Trident Training Facility with a wide array of simulators, a catered lunch with the crew of the Trident sub that we will then visit on the pier after lunch. www.csg9.navy.mil.
- Final instructions will be provided to confirmed registrants; there will be a waiting list. Preference will be given to our corporate sponsors but their registrations must be received by September 10th. The last date for receipt of registrations is tentatively is September 20th – all subject to Navy Regulations which now **require that each visitor provide proof of US citizenship by bringing a passport or birth certificate** in addition to official identification such as a driver's license. REGISTRATION BY MAIL ONLY TO MEDINA PO BOX!
- **NO EXCEPTIONS – last year 6 people were turned away for no passport or birth certificate!**

- Registration (Registration is closer to deadlines because we are always subject to change by Navy)
 - Photo id and proof of US citizenship required and US Citizens only
 - Minimum age 16 and minors need to be accompanied by adult
 - Tour includes climbing up and down ladders in confined spaces 4-5 stories; please wear appropriate garb and walking shoes (no open toes)
 - Cost per person \$20 to accompany registration for your lunch, lunch for 1 crew member 2 guests, and a contribution to the Morale-Welfare-Recreation fund (residual)
 - **Deadline - receipt by September 20th ; preferential deadline September 10th**
