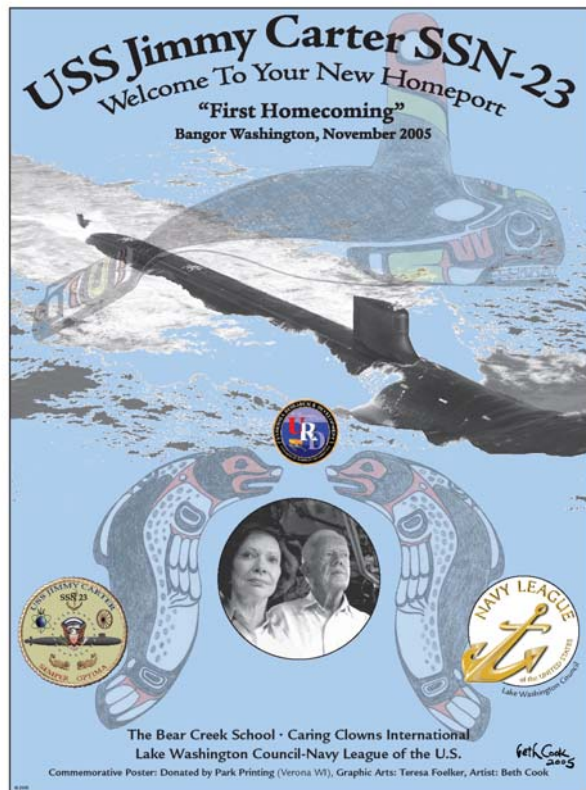


Lake Washington Council Adopts USS Jimmy Carter & Undersea Research & Development
